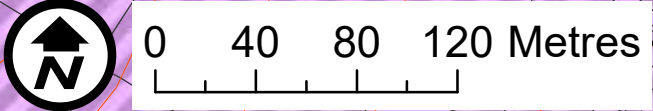


**Perranuthnoe Parish

Map 13 - Overview**



Western edge is on the plateau and is visible from the wider landscape. Hedges beyond don't contain trees to screen the views.

The open nature of the landscape to the west and the lack of trees mean the settlement edge is invisible approaching from the west.

Views of the northern settlement edge are limited due to topography and Cornish hedges with tree and shrub growth.

Views of the northern boundary very limited due to flat ground and trees and shrubs in the Cornish hedge.

Vegetation on the A394 screens views of the houses on this section of the southern boundary.

Open views of the southern boundary. Generally properties are bungalows which limit their visual impact.

The vegetation on the edge of the settlement softens the built edge integrating it with the rural landscape.

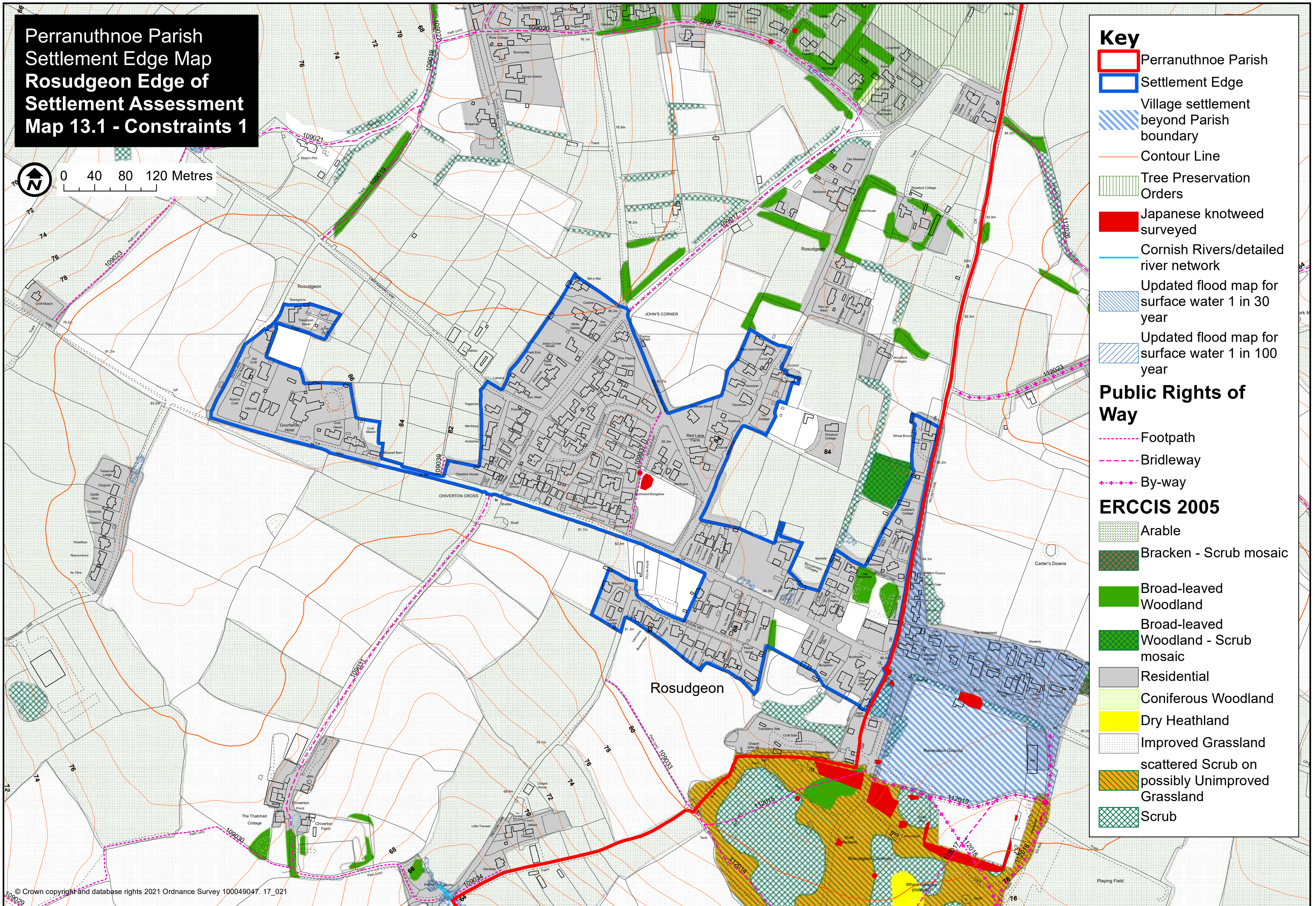
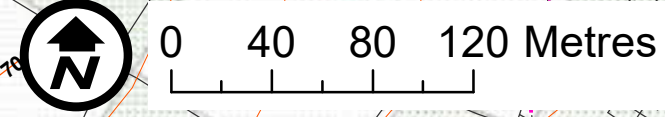



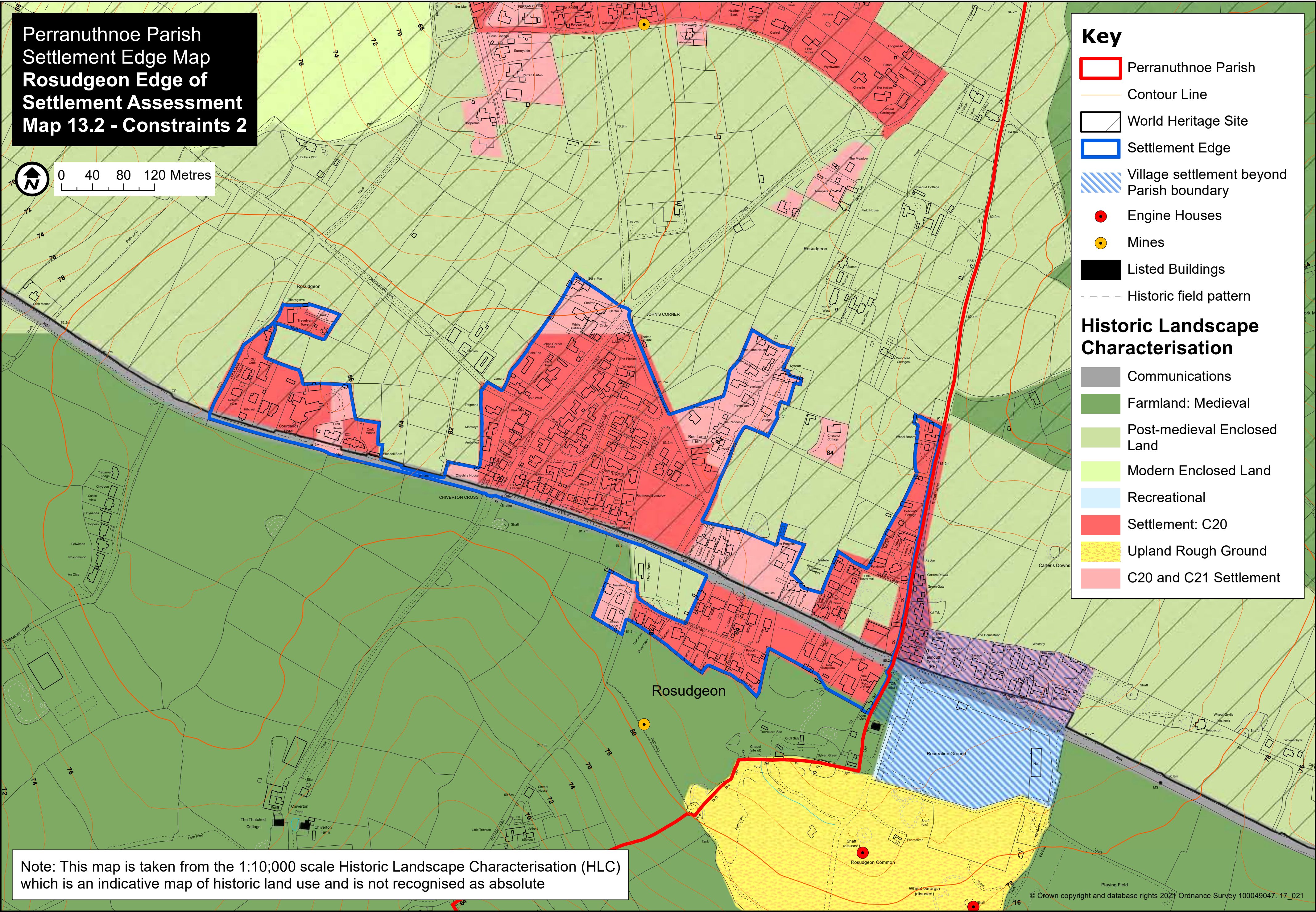
